



Linking English and Maths Learning Skills to Accelerate Children's Progress

In order to look at how the subjects of English and Mathematics join together, Alison Philipson (literacy consultant) and Sharon Day (maths consultant) are offering your school training around the common learning techniques needed to be able to access the KS2 SATs tests, primarily inference and reasoning, linked to both Maths and English.

There will be three afternoon sessions with gap tasks and it is hoped that both subject leaders for mathematics and English at your school will be able to attend together for all three sessions.

It is expected that your subject leaders will share the techniques, designed to ensure that children in all year groups meet age-related expectations as well as meeting the expectations at the end of their primary education, with teachers across school.
